

MONONGAHELA AQUATORIUM CODE OF CONDUCT (Effective October, 2012)

Aquatorium Innovations, Inc. in tandem with the City of Monongahela, PA has developed a visitor code of conduct for all events held at the Monongahela Aquatorium. It is our intent to ensure that all visitors have a safe and happy experience while attending events at the Aquatorium.

Our goal is to provide a positive experience from the time that visitors enter the City limits through the event time at the Aquatorium, until the time that they leave the City limits. We would like for all of our visitors to enjoy the Aquatorium experience in a positive and responsible fashion.

When attending an event at the Aquatorium, please refrain from any of the following behaviors/activities:

- Verbal or physical harassment of any other persons within the Aquatorium and surrounding areas.
- Obscene gestures
- Foul or abusive language
- Failing to follow instructions of Aquatorium and Security personnel
- Intoxication resulting in irresponsible behavior
- Interference with any event activity (including verbal harassment)
- Any behavior that is illegal in nature
- Any behavior that is irresponsible in nature

Rockin' on the Mon! TM pass holders and all other attendees are responsible for their individual conduct during all events whether seated, visiting concession stands, restrooms, or simply standing. Aquatorium Security will intervene to support an environment where all persons attending are able to do so in an enjoyable and safe manner.

In addition, please do not bring outside food or beverages into the Aquatorium during Rockin' on the Mon! TM events. Glass bottles/containers of ANY kind are prohibited and will not be available for purchase on these premises.

Any event patron that violates these provisions will be subject to removal from the premises without refund, and potential loss of ticket privileges for future events. Aquatorium Innovations, Inc. reserves the right to revoke ticket privileges of any person who has violated any of the above types of conduct.
